Facts on Student Employment:

- Must maintain enrollment of 3 units in the Summer and 6 units in Fall and Spring semesters
- Valid driver's license necessary
- Pay begins at \$10.50/ hour and can increase after certain criteria are met
- Part time employment 15 – 25 hours/ week
- We will work with your school schedule

Sales & Distribution Assistant

Job duties may include:

- Help staff the farmstand on campus selling produce
- Organizing & delivering CSA boxes
- Delivering produce to various customers
- Developing promotional materials including flyers, post cards, and e-mails
- Using Quickbooks to enter weekly invoices & balance records

Livestock Assistant

- We have cattle, sheep, horses, and burros at the farm
- Feed animals and clean living areas daily
- Assist with health maintenance such as deworming and vaccinations, wound care, calving, and lambing
- Help is needed on both weekdays and weekends

Garden Assistant

Job duties may include:

- Learning the ins & outs of growing produce at Shone Farm
- Helping with planting, irrigation, weeding, harvesting, etc.
- Picking & packing produce with quality control in mind
- Learning the different varieties, and what grows best in our climate
- Developing awareness and skills for farming during a drought
